Main Job Purpose:

Responsible for the use of advanced machinery for the production of timber windows, doors and trims.

Various machines include an automated cross cut, Band re-saw and four-sided planer this would be the initial equipment to be used.

Can be quite a physical job but the lifting is more than manageable.

Feeding and tailing of the relevant machines as required.

Sorting and stacking of timber for the next operation.

Only basic square cutting and planning

Quite noisy, ear protection must be worn in this area.

Larger main production machine (Window line) can entail shift work with the possibility of lone working.

Main Duties of Role:

- · Operate machine as per company and manufacturer intent.
- Manufacture the Company's products, in accordance with the customer's requirements, the Management System and the Employee's field of specialisation.
- Check products to ensure accuracy and compliance with Quality standards.
- Ensure all required maintenance procedures are adhered to.
- Carry out and comply with all company policies, procedures and instructions and any other reasonable duties deemed necessary by the company.
- Observe all safety rules and procedures, ensuring that the work area, equipment and materials are left in a safe state; and that reasonable care is taken for the health and safety of all fellow employees and any other persons within the work area.
- Work in a manner that actively seeks to reduce any negative environmental impact in relation to the processes and procedures operating within their area and across the wider business e.g. reduction of waste, recycling etc.

- Use of woodworking machinery and hand tools.
